Supplies for Summer Camp

TRY TO LABEL EVERYTHING

PACKED

(R) Lunch for Sunday
(R) Medications – in labeled Ziploc bag with dispensing instructions TURN IN BEFORE LEAVING
(R) Troop 309 T-Shirt(s) “Class B” (WEAR 2010 VERSION ON SUNDAY)
(R) Rain gear (poncho or rain suit) PACKED ON TOP
(R) Boy Scout Uniform Shirt with correct and current badges PACKED ON TOP
(R) Swim suit PACKED ON TOP
(R) <i>Boy Scout Handbook</i> in waterproof container/bag
(R) Merit Badge Prerequisites (verified by a Troop Leader before 6/15)
(R) Pipestone Award (not applicable for 1 st year campers)
(R) Pipestone Wood (1 ft ³ of straight bark-less hardwood tied/bundled)
(R) Sunscreen
(R) Water Bottle
(R) Insect Spray/Lotion
(R) Knot Tying Rope (3-4 feet)
(R) Sleeping bag/bedding/pajamas + pillow
(R) Cot – With large furniture coasters/wood (to prevent from puncturing tent floor).
(R) Flashlight/headlamp with extra batteries
(R) Pocket knife or Leatherman – NO SHEATH/HUNTING KNIVES
(R) Mess Kit (plate, bowl, cup) and mesh bag for retrieving from boiling water
(R) Vitt-L-Kit (knife, fork, spoon)
(R) Lightweight Jacket or Polar Fleece
(R) Hat or some type of head cover
(R) Money for Trading Post (candy, ice cream, etc. -- \$25 should be plenty)
(R) Money for craft-type Merit Badge fees
(R) Pencils/Pens/Paper (for Merit Badge work)
(R) Pants with Belt (at least 2 pair) (+1 if taking Swimming MB)
(R) Shirts - Short Sleeve (5) (T-Shirts are fine – no “loud” or potentially offensive designs)
(R) Shirts - Long Sleeve (2) (+1 if taking Swimming MB)
(R) Shoes/Boots with ankle support
(R) BSA and other Shorts (3)
(R) Socks (8 minimum)
(R) Tennis Shoes – <u>Sandals are prohibited</u>
(R) Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
(R) Towels (2)
(R) Underwear (7)
(R) Dirty Laundry Bag or container
(R) Order of the Arrow Sash (if applicable)
OPTIONAL ITEMS
(O) Beach or “water” shoes – for use in aquatics area and shower only.
(O) Rope for Clothes Line
(O) Camera/film
(O) Camp Chair/Stool
(O) Fishing Gear
(O) SMALL backpack or bookbag to carry Merit Badge work to/from campsite.

We strongly recommend Tupperware-type storage containers to hold all personal gear (x-cots).
